Our Christian Values

As a Church of England School, our Christian Values tie in with 'Let your light shine' Matthew 5:16. We let our light shine through our good learning, actions and words towards the members of our school community and our local community.

We believe that for our children to let their light shine they need to embody our five school values of; Respect, Resilience, Trust, Honesty and Thankfulness.

These values are taught to our children during whole school assemblies and the children are rewarded as part of our 'Star Learner' certificates. On the last Friday of each month, we choose a 'Star Learner' who has demonstrated one of our school values.

It is also important for us to learn and respect other faiths, annual, national and international commemorative dates across the school year. We do this through our assemblies in school, as well as lessons. For example; Anti-bullying week, Science Week, Advent, Diwali and Ramadan.

We tell stories, share experiences and have visitors lead assemblies. As well as empowering our children to lead class assemblies, musical recitals, choirs, choreographed dances and school council assemblies. This is really where our school values come to the fore as our children have the resilience and trust in each other to let their light shine through their involvement in whole school activities, which they share with our school community.
