

Instrument of Government

COLD HARBOUR CHURCH OF ENGLAND SCHOOL

- 1 The name of the school is Cold Harbour Church of England School.
- 2 The school is a voluntary controlled school.
- 3 The name of the governing body is "The governing body of Cold Harbour Church of England School".
- 4 The governing body shall consist of:
 - 4 parent governors
 - 1 LA governor
 - 1 staff governor
 - 1 headteacher
 - 2 foundation governors
 - 2 co-opted governors
- 5 The total number of governors shall be 11, except that at any time when the headteacher has given written notice to the clerk to the governors that s/he does not wish to be a governor, the total shall be 10.
- 6 Foundation governors shall be appointed by the Oxford Diocesan Board of Education.
- 7 The school has a trust deed dated 2 March 1840.
- 8 Recognising its historic foundation, the school will preserve and develop its religious character in accordance with the principles of the Church of England and in partnership with the Church at parish and diocesan levels.

The school aims to serve its community by providing an education of the highest quality within the context of Christian belief and practice. It encourages an understanding of the meaning and significance of faith and promotes Christian values through the experience it offers to all its pupils.

- 10 This instrument of government comes into effect on 1 September 2015.
- 11 This instrument was made by order of Milton Keynes Local Authority on 25 August 2015.
- 12 A copy of the instrument must be supplied to every member of the governing body (and the head teacher if not a governor), any trustees and the Oxford Diocesan Board of Education.
