
### Rules and Responsibilities

**Science:** Living things and their habitats, Forces and magnets


**History:** The Roman Empire and its impact on Britain

• You will receive one piece of maths and one piece of English (usually grammar of punctuation) per week.






 You will also have spellings sent home to learn for a weekly test.
