
As a Christian school we have thought carefully about our values, and we have chosen five core values which we feel particularly relevant and pertinent to life at Cold Harbour.

- Start to make some friends!




Stay and Play Sessions

- Your child will then be invited to two sessions on their own.
- First session on Thursday 7th July for an hour.
- Second session on Thursday 14th July for either a morning or afternoon.
- Approximately 12 children in each session.
- Bring own drink (water bottle).
- Try some different activities and play with new friends!
- On **Thursday 14th July** in between the sessions we will be having a teddy bears picnic **11.30-12.30** for all children and parents to meet.
- Bring your own picnic and blanket!

Home visits

- In your pack there will be a date and time for a home visit in September.
- Two members of staff will visit.
- This is an opportunity to ask any questions, talk through any concerns or worries and tell us all about your little person.
- It is a great way for the children to meet us where they feel comfortable.
- The visit lasts about 20 minutes.
- Home learning pack.
- Prepare your child by getting them to think of something special that they could share with us. It could be an object, story or something homemade ©

What happens when my child starts school?

- September...
- Home visits in the morning and then start school that afternoon.
- All children will attend in the morning on Thursday 8th September and stay for lunch.
- On Friday 9th September all children will have their first full day in school.
- The children will then be in full time the following week.

What will happen on the first full day?

- Doors open at 8.40am- The teacher will greet you at the classroom door
- School starts at 8.45am
- During the morning we do phonics and reading. We have lots of activities to choose from inside and outside.
- Snack time- fruit and vegetables are provided. Water is available in class but most children choose to bring their own water bottle. Sign up for milk!
- Number time
- 12.00pm Lunchtime
- Afternoon- We develop our knowledge and understanding of the world, physical development and communication and language through fun activities!
- 3.15pm- Too quickly the day is over!

Where will my child eat lunch?

 When your child starts at Cold Harbour, you will have a choice of a packed lunch or school dinner for them.

• As a 'Healthy School' we expect you to bring a healthy packed lunch- no sweets or products that contain nuts.

All Foundation children eat their lunch in the hall together.

After lunch they play on the playground and field.

• For the first few weeks the children in Foundation have a designated area until we feel they are ready.

• Classdojo- Reward system where all children have a dojo and collect dojo points. There is also a class story where we share learning or events in school.




- Half termly knowledge organiser and newsletter to keep you updated about what we are learning in school.
- Sign up to parentmail- receive all the school letters and reminders to your email account (in pack)
- Tapestry- online learning journal.

We have a robust approach to the development of early reading. Following the Read Write Inc programme our younger children gain solid foundations in phonics.




Phonics workshop for parents in the second week and a Maths workshop after the October half term.



Power maths is a curriculum mastery programme designed to spark curiosity and excitement and nurture confidence in maths. It focuses on helping our youngest children to build a deep understanding of maths concepts.

What can you be doing?

- Attend the stay and play sessions.
- Practise getting dressed- can they put their own coat on? Hat? Gloves? Can they put on their shoes?
- Use the toilet on their own.
- Encourage independence.
- Share stories.
- Talk about what will happen at school.
- Share the photos in the Welcome booklet.
- Fill out the All About Me book.
